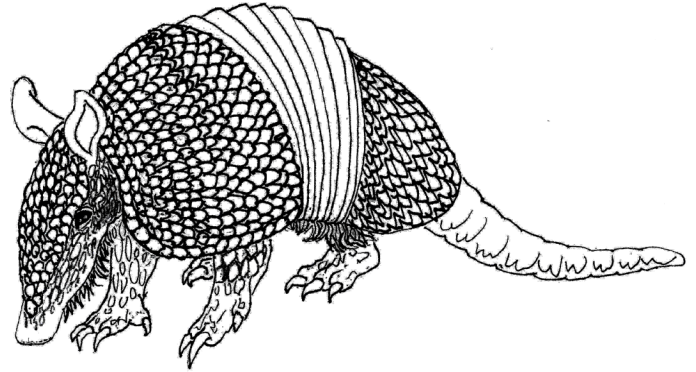

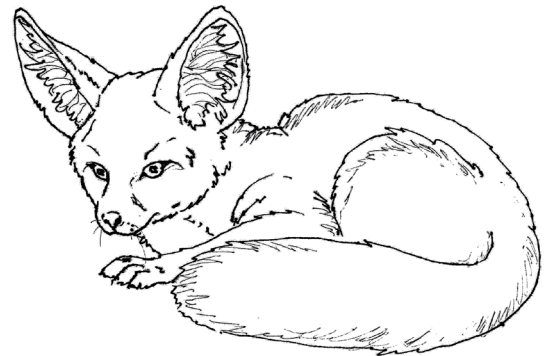
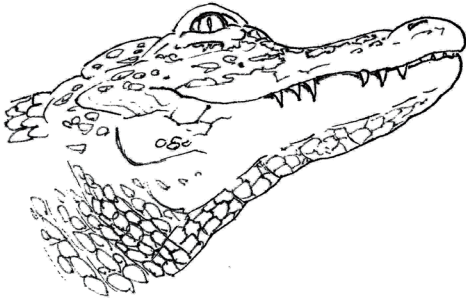

Hint: Their nickname is "Honey Bear".

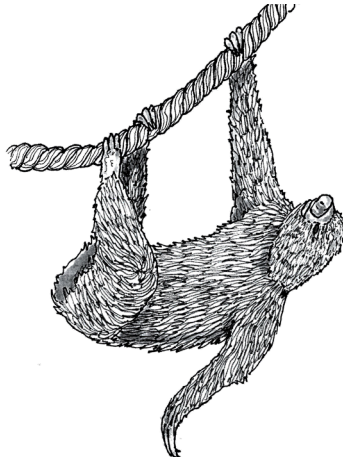


How do they carry their babies?

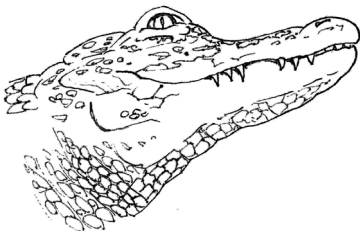
Kangaroo

What is a baby kangaroo called?

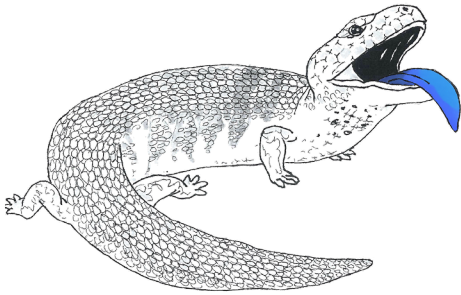
Adaptations

Animals have adapted in various ways to survive the environment they are in. For example: fish have developed lungs to help them breathe in water, monkeys have developed opposable thumbs to help them climb trees.

Desert:



Blue Tongued Skink

-They have a blue tongue to trick predators into thinking they are poisonous. Bright colors in nature = poison

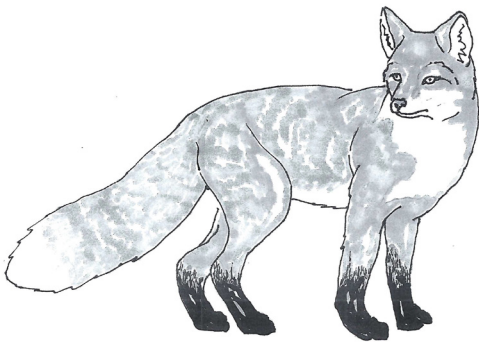
Rainforest/Tropics:



Capybara

-They have webbed feet to help them swim

Woodland/Forest:



Red Fox

-They have big ears to help them hear prey

Mountains:



Chinchilla

-They have padded paws that help them climb rocks better

Grassland/Prairie:



Buffalo

-They are herbivores, so they only need grass to survive.

Arctic:

Based on what you've learned, what adaptations do you think an animal would need to survive in the freezing arctic weather?

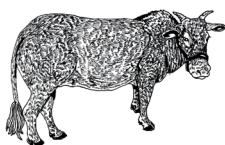
