**1** How many **guinea pigs** does this Sustainable Safari location have?




**2** How does Sustainable Safari practice **sustainability**? Name at least two ways.

**4** What do you need to "beware" of? (*Hint:* look up at the **goat** signs.)




**5** What is the name of our biggest **kangaroo**?

**7** What kind of **birds** are hanging out with the kangaroos?




**8** How many different bird species do we have around the zoo?

**12** Find and name three animals we have that naturally live in **South America**.




**13** True or False? The **binturong** has the nickname “Bearcat” because it is most closely related to bears and cats. (Bonus: If false, what are they more closely related to?)



**14** List one species at our zoo that is classified as either **vulnerable** or **endangered**.



**15** There are at *least* 3 **porcupine** species currently in our zoo. What are they? (Bonus: Can you find more than 3? Extra Bonus: What makes them different from each other?)



**16** True or False? **Porcupines** can shoot their quills.


**17** Name four **nocturnal** animals that we have. Are any of them awake right now? (Bonus: What does nocturnal mean?)



**18** Even with rings on their tails, **ring-tailed lemurs** are not related to **raccoons**. Name an animal that is related to raccoons. (*Hint*: Look at the display board about **Procyonids**.)



**19** True or False? One of the **crocodilians** in the pool is not an **alligator**. If true, what is it?  
(Bonus: Find "Gator Boy" and ask for a fun fact about crocodilians.)
