

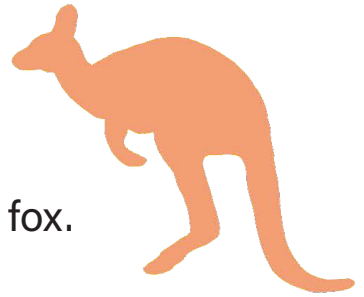
Sustainable Safari - Maplewood Scavenger Hunt Challenge

2 True or False? **Fennec foxes** are the *smallest* species of fox.



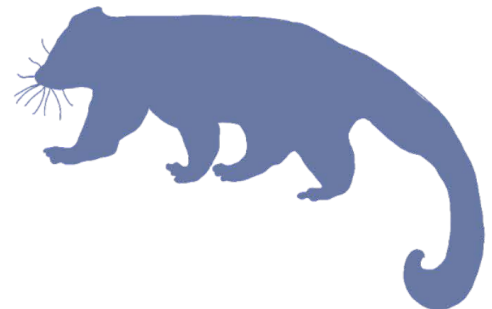
3 Which animal is most likely going to steal your cup?

(**Bonus:** If false, what are they more closely related to?)



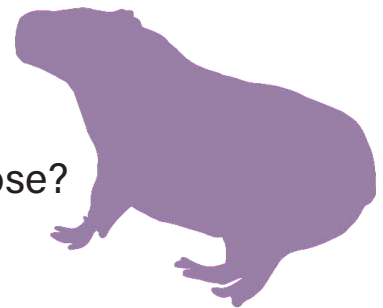


6 If those pokey animals by the cashier *aren't* hedgehogs, what are they?

7 What is the name of our *slowest* mammal?

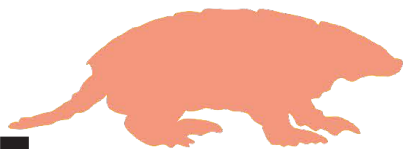


8 Those *aren't* baby **capybaras** with Bobby, what are they?

What kind of animal is it? Ask a Safari Guide about the tortoise shell.



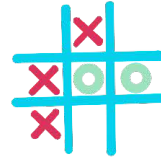
11 What is the name of the place where our **chickens** roost?

15 List one species at our zoo that is classified as either **vulnerable** or **endangered**.

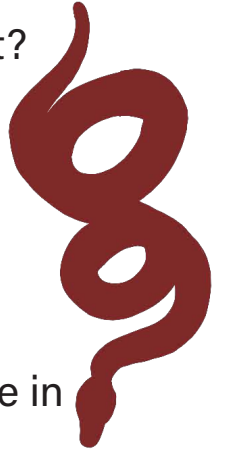


16 True or False? **Porcupines** can *shoot* their quills.

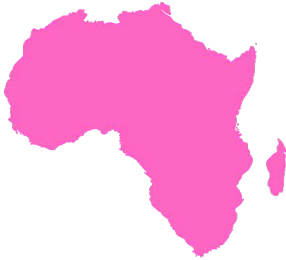
17 Many of our animals have pools to swim in and are **semi-aquatic**. What are they? (**Bonus**: What does semi-aquatic mean?)
